Introduction to Speaker



Trey L. Petty, D.D.S., F.A.G.D., F.A.D.I.

Following medical school at the University of British Columbia, Dr. Petty graduated from dental school at the University of Alberta. From there, he moved to New York City where he did his graduate studies in Oral Medicine at Columbia University with training at the Long Island Jewish Medical Center, an affiliate hospital of Harvard University. Following this, he remained in New York City on the dental staff at several hospitals before moving back to Alberta in the late 1980's.

He is currently director of the Department of Dentistry and Oral Medicine at the Foothills Medical Centre and the Tom Baker Cancer Center in Calgary and is an Associate Professor in Surgery at the University of Calgary, Faculty of Medicine. He is the past Chair of the Committee for Community and Institutional Dentistry for the Canadian Dental Association and is on the Infection Control Committee for the Alberta Dental Association. Dr. Petty authored the Canadian Dental Association's Guidelines & Workbook on Infection Control. Trey has been named as a Distinguished Alumni from the University of Alberta and is the dental consultant for Southern Alberta for the Alberta Cancer Board. Dr. Petty received the Award of Merit and a Certificate of Merit from the Canadian Dental Association and is the recent past-Trustee for Western Canada for the Academy of General Dentistry.

Trey's practice at the Foothills Medical Centre in Calgary is limited to the mentally and physically challenged, medically compromised, head and neck cancer and geriatric patient and a variety of other things that no one else wants to do.
