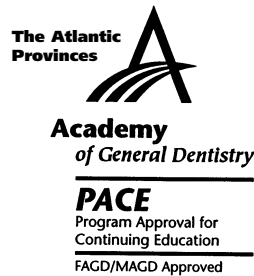

Dr. Timothy Foley is adjunct professor and previous director of the Graduate Orthodontic Clinic, Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry, University of Western Ontario. He holds a cross appointment with the Division of Orthodontics and Paediatric Dentistry. He has published extensively in national and international journals and is currently a reviewer for Angle Orthodontics, the Journal of the Canadian dental Associate, and the American Journal of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics. His current research projects include orthodontic bonding studies, fluoride release from orthodontic adhesives and treatment outcome studies of class II malocclusions.■

Dr. Sergio Weinberger is Associated Clinical Professor, Undergraduate and Graduate Orthodontics, The University of Western Ontario, Private Practice, London, Ontario. Dr. Weinberger obtained his dental degree and graduate orthodontics degrees from the University Autonomous of Guadalajara, Mexico. He obtained his specialty in pediatric dentistry from the University of Maryland and his orthodontic specialty from the University of Western Ontario. He maintains an active private practice in pediatric dentistry and orthodontics.■

Objectives: This course will expose participants to the numerous changes in pediatric dentistry and orthodontics in the past few years. The presenters will review and cover topics in every day general practice.

Synopsis: Dr. Weinberger will cover sedation techniques for the pediatric dental patient and early treatment approach in the child. His review will also include the management of impacted canines. Dr. Foley will review diagnosis and treatment planning in the restorative and periodontal patient. The complexities of managing the adult patient will be covered by review of cases.
