

Specific areas to be discussed include selection of Bonding Agents, Air Abrasion, Bulk Fill products, ceramic restoratives decision making, and cementation protocols.

LAYING IT DOWN: CREATE BEAUTIFUL ANTERIOR COMPOSITE RESTORATIONS

This "Laying It Down" course focuses on creating beautiful anterior composite restorations using contemporary direct composite systems. Participants will learn how to conservatively and aesthetically restore teeth to mimic natural tooth structure. Key topics include shade selection, replicating natural tooth morphology, and finishing techniques. The course offers hands-on experience with composite characteristics, layering strategies, and various types of composite restorations.
